

The **Ülemiste Dome** concept is a community-oriented spatial idea that would create a wellbeing and connection network in Ülemiste City, made up of two small but meaningful dome spaces.

The idea is to have, for example, **two domes** where people could, even during winter: step away from work-related stress, recharge, gather or share thoughts, connect with others, and simply take a moment for themselves.

The goal would be to create small spaces in Ülemiste City that: support mental wellbeing, create better balance in working life, strengthen the sense of community, and encourage human connection.

The vision is for these domes to be heated, with access by chip/card for employees, students, entrepreneurs, managers, and others in the community.

One dome could be intended for people who want to create work-related connections and interact with others. The second dome could be a **peace dome** — a place to reflect, collect ideas, sit quietly, enjoy soft calming music that helps with relaxation, and browse thoughtful or useful books.

The domes could be called **“Us” and “Me”** or **“Connection” and “Balance.”**

People could be on their own, but not isolated. This idea does not create separated zones — quite the opposite, it brings people together through space. It would encourage conversations, a sense of belonging, a safe communal environment, and spontaneous encounters.

Ülemiste is not just a workplace — it is a community.
